

Bearing

Based on a series of six solar observations taken May 17, 1966, at the west 1/4 corner of Section 14, T. 35 S., R. 1 W. W.M.

Purpose :

The creation of Hillandale Park Subdivision as platted

PROCEDURE

In that the south boundary of the subdivision coincides with the northerly boundary of D.R. 455-485, it was necessary to locate the southerly boundary of DLC 41 and establish a line parallel thereto and 330 feet northerly thereof.

A thorough search in the area led to the recovery of the west 1/4 corner of Section 14 which was reestablished holding distance superior to bearing from the remains of the original witness trees. Measuring south along a fence line record distance led to the recovery of the southwest corner of DLC 41 which was reestablished in the same manner as above.

These corner locations were checked against record by remeasurement to the northwest corner of DLC 41 and found to be in reasonable harmony with official government survey records. Corroborative evidence is listed below in support of the reestablishment of these two corners.

1/4 corner common to Sections 14 and 15

Found a mound of rock flush with ground surface from which a pine root crown bears N 39°04'15" E 30.36 feet (Rec. N 39°E 30.36 feet), an oak root crown bears S 45°29'15" W 146.52 feet (Rec. S 46°W 146.52 feet) from which evidence I set a brass capped 3/4"x30" iron pin for corner and scribed a 15" White oak "1/4 S15 483BT" which bears N 68°37'45" W 228.84 feet distant and a 15" White oak "1/4 S14 483BT" which bears S 37°24' E 186.70 feet distant. The northwest corner of DLC 41 bears N 0°13' E 2109.33 feet (Rec. North 2096.82 feet).

1/4 corner common to Sections 13 and 14

I set a brass capped 3/4"x30" iron pin for corner from which the root hole of a down oak snag (with reverse scribing) bears N 71°41'10" E 122.67 feet (Rec. N 70% E 124.74 feet) and a 14" White oak (with reverse scribing) which bears N 69°47'30" W 48.18 feet (Rec. N 71°W 48.18 feet). I held record distance to the latter superior as said witness tree is closer and was not referenced along the slope. I scribed an 8" Black oak "1/4 S13 483BT" which bears N 75°39'10" E 99.19 feet distant. Corner falls approximately 20 feet east of a north-south fence line.

SE corner of D.L.C. 41

I set a brass capped 3/4"x30" iron pin for corner from which the root crown of a down oak snag (with old axe work visible) bears S 51 W 20,46 feet according to record, a Black oak with scribing visible bears N 70 49' 50" E 36.30 feet (Rec. N 73 E 36.30 feet) and a Black oak with axed face bears N 30 52'10" W 28.38 feet (Rec. N 31 W 28.38 feet). The east 1/4 corner of Section 14 bears N 0 18'20" E 561.33 feet (Rec. North 561.00 feet) and the southwest corner of DLC 41 bears S 89 58'10" W


Survey narrative for Hillandale Park Subdivision (cont'd.)

SW corner of D.L.C. 41

Set a brass capped 3/4"x30" iron pin for corner from which an oak root crown bears N $33^{\circ}52^{\circ}15"$ E 96.36 feet (Rec. N 34% E 96.36 feet) and an oak root crown bears S $41^{\circ}33^{\circ}15"$ W 49.50 feet (Rec. S 42° W 49.50 feet). The west 1/4 corner of Section 14 bears N $0^{\circ}12^{\circ}45"$ W 540.30 feet (Rec. North 543.18 feet).

The existing Reese Creek road does not coincide with the original road petition as surveyed by J.S. Howard in May of 1870. Inasmuch as the property lying westerly of said road (D.R. 574-339) is described as running down the center line of said road and deed record places the point of beginning on the east edge thereof, said east edge was held as centerline to insure at least 30 feet of road way to the county. A quit claim deed to the other 30 feet should probably be obtained from the adjacent owner to insure a 60 feet right-of-way.
