

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250, REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR: White City Corporation

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a tract proposed to be conveyed to the United Telephone Company of the Northwest.

PROCEDURE: Found Avenue monuments and points previously set for the present lease parcel.

Measured along the centerline of Avenue "G" from the concrete monument found at Thirteenth Street, Easterly to the concrete monument found at Nineteenth Street, tying in the points shown as set on the existing lease tract. Then monumented the additional tract as shown.

This Section corner tie was utilized from Recorded Survey No. 2804.

Because of the ambiguity of the tie to the "centerline" of State Highway 62 as described in the present lease description, an overall tract description was developed and tied to said Section corner.
