PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

From previous survey no. 2493 and previous traverse made sub-division Northwest one quarter corner of Section 36.

Tract of land with cabin on as shown having conflicting location of record (see Deed Record, Vol. 400, page 451, Vol. 281, page 505, Vol. 462, page 219) was determined by what appears to be the intent which may leave a portion of said tract over-lapping in the Southwest one quarter which is held under a different title at a time of convenience.

Monuments set being 5/8 x 24 inch iron pins, set approximately flush with surface.

Northwest corner of Sec. 36, 2 inch iron pipe.

North one quarter of Sec. 36, survey no. 2493.

East one quarter, found $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe.
