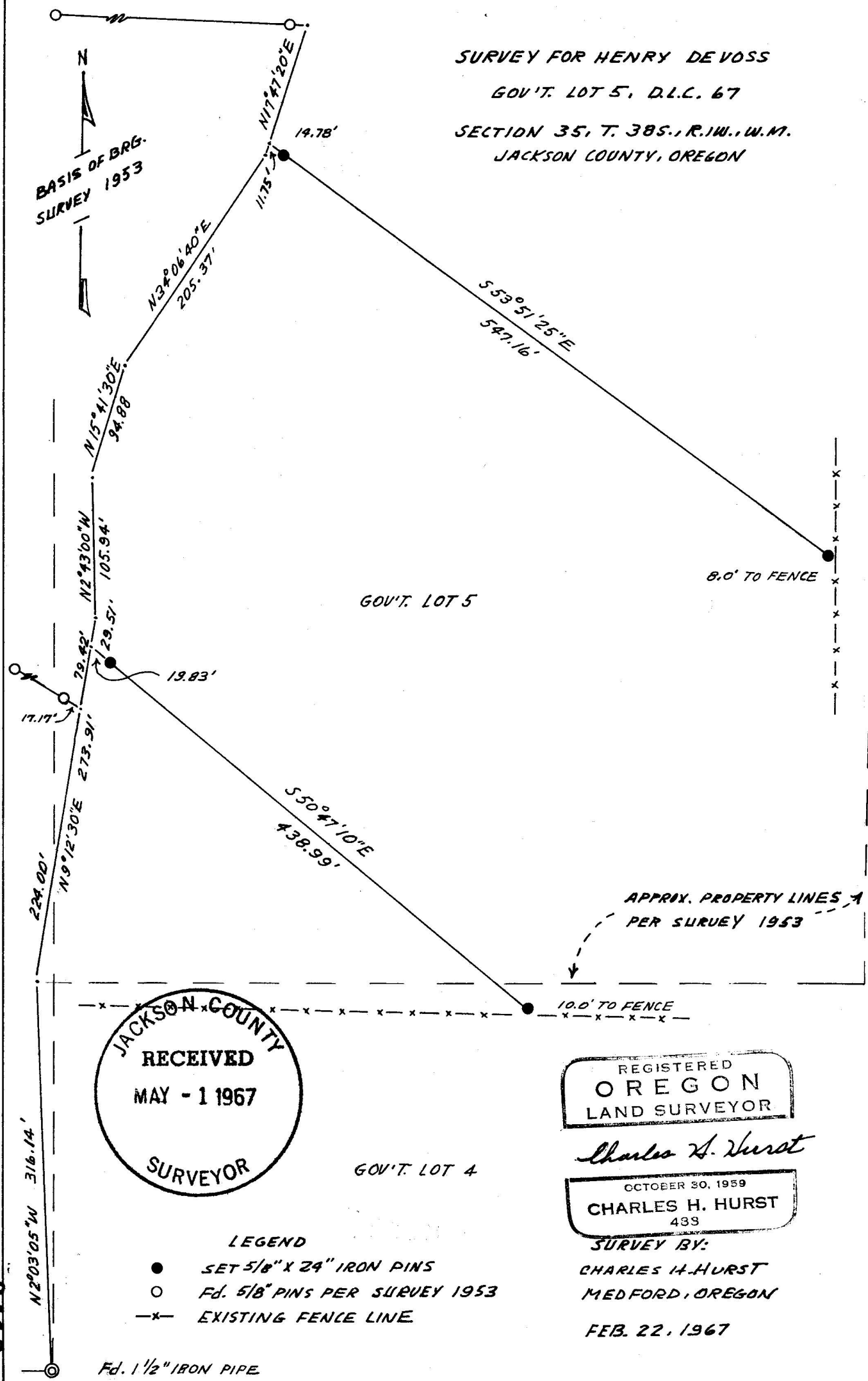

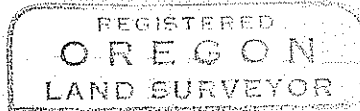
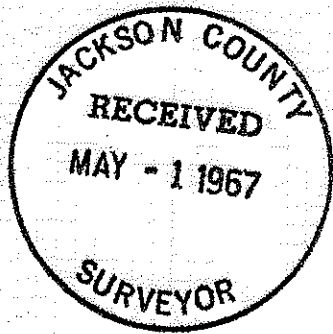
PROCEDURE OF SURVEY

In that it was not deemed economically feasible by the client to have located the east and south boundary of the parent tract, the two division lines shown were established by closing on the two iron pins set on the Westerly side of Rapp Lane per recorded survey No. 1953.

From the deed line thus determined, the two tangents were established in relation thereto at a location designated by the client.

Accordingly, the two pins set at the termination of said tangents control for line only.
