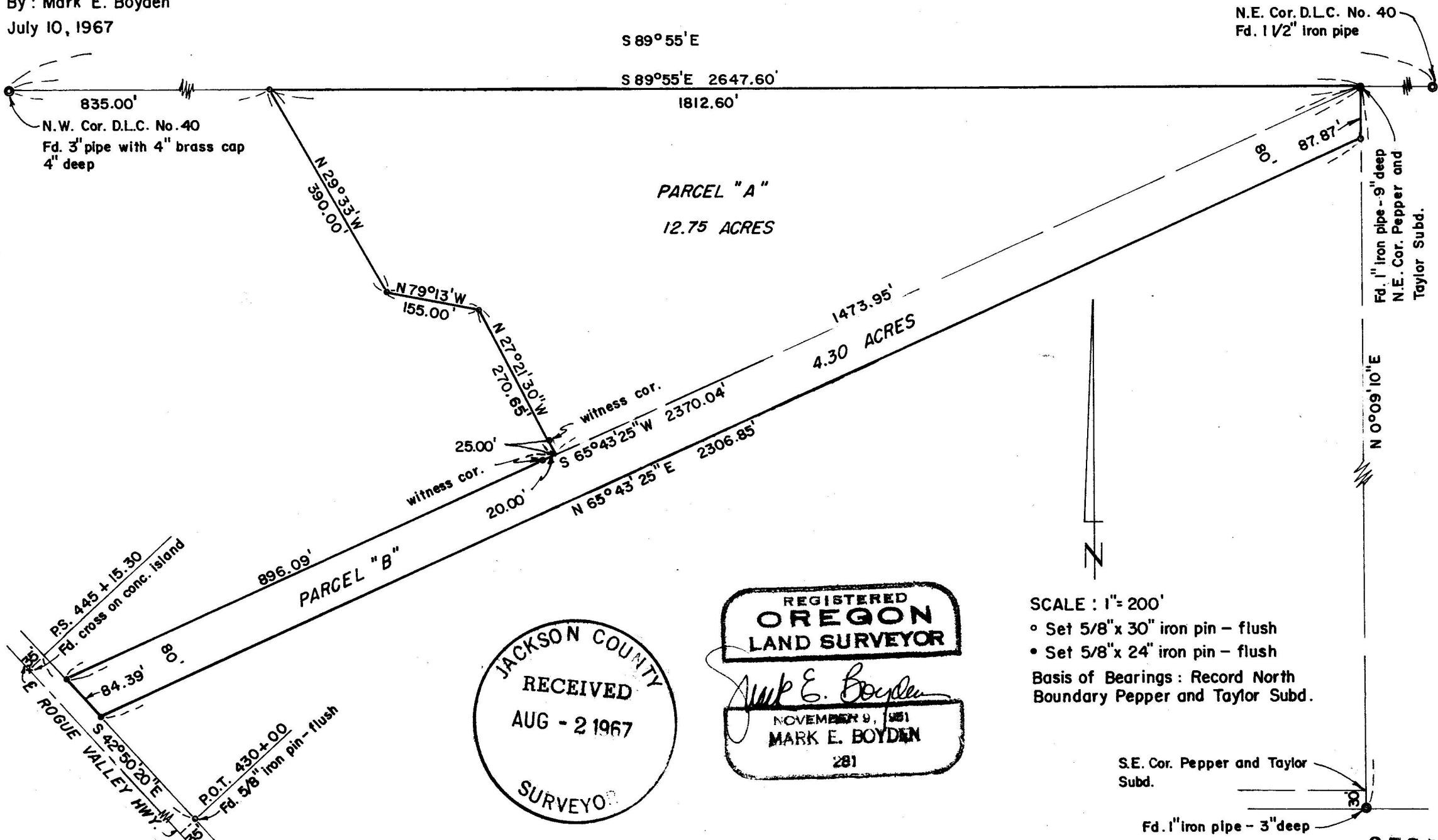

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

Survey For: Jackson County  
Courthouse  
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a portion of the PEPPER  
and TAYLOR SUBDIVISION as directed.

PROCEDURE:

From the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No.40,  
traversed to a 1" pipe found for the Northeast corner of said  
subdivision, (said pipe having been set on Recorded Survey #1287).  
Also traversed to a 1" pipe located 30.0 feet Southerly from the  
Southeast corner of said subdivision. The Rogue Valley Highway  
was located from monuments as indicated and tied together for  
varification.

From the above controls, monumented the subject tract as  
shown on the map to accompany this report.
