Commenced at the northeast corner of Section 12; thence ran a line S 89° 55' W, along the Section line(the 1/16th corner set by RS # 3428

was visible).

Set a 3/4" G.I.P. and tag(R.E. 5604) at 690.0 feet on the west edge of a 60' R/W per the deed.

Measured South 215 feet to the approximate centerline of Evans Creek.

Turned and meeaured Due North, 427.80 feet to the southerly R/W line of Evans Creek Road (60) sixty feet wide and set a 3/4" G.I.P. and tag (R.E. 5604).

Continued S 89° 55' W, along the north line of Section 12, 315.0 feet to a point 1015.0 feet west of the Northeast corner thereof and set a 3/4" G.I.P. and tag(R.E. 5604) from
