Said tree presently measures 13", and a small piece of reverse scribe was found in the now hollow interior of said tree. A meridian was brought to corner location from recent bearings of record for the South line of said Section 36, where the South 1/4 corner, and the Southeast corner were found as reestablished. At the corner location I placed a 1" iron pipe with a brass cap

stamped T.35S., R.2W.
