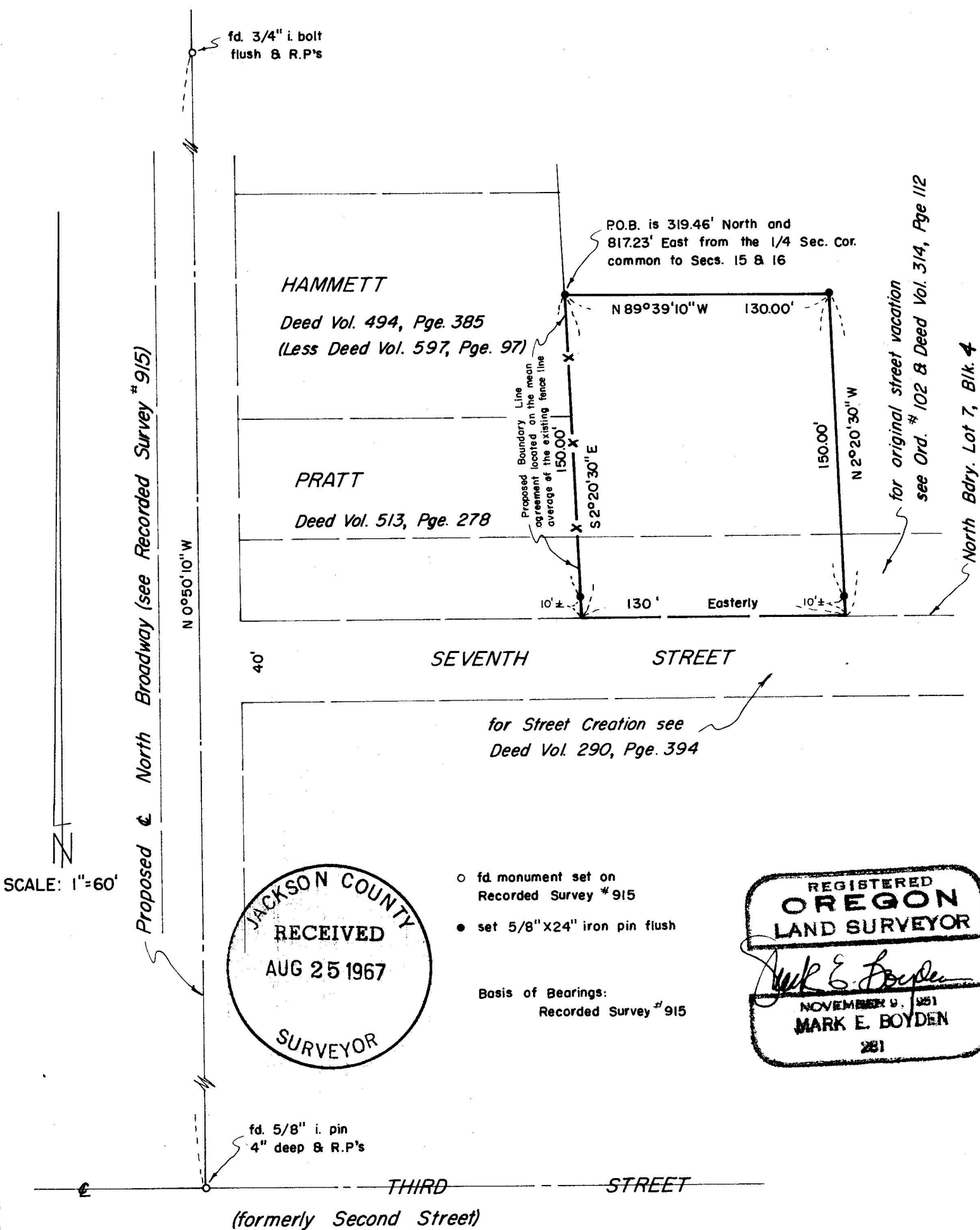

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Willis Stiehl
P. O. Box 193
Rogue River, Oregon

PURPOSE: (1) To monument and describe a proposed boundary line agreement between the Stiehl, Hammett and Pratt properties.
(2) To monument and describe a tract proposed to be conveyed by Stiehl after the boundary line agreement is recorded.

PROCEDURE: Found the 1" iron pipe corner monument as re-established by the County Surveyor for the Quarter corner common to Sections 15 and 16 and traversed to around the subject parcel, tying to the proposed centerline of North Broadway as monumented on Recorded Survey #915 for meridian control.

Monumented the desired parcel as shown, setting witness corners for side line control, as the true North boundary of Seventh Street was not determined on this survey.
