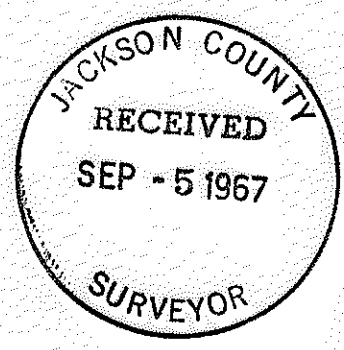
SURVEY FOR: James L. Cowie  
Route 1, Box 334 Footh Creek Road  
Gold Hill, Oregon

LOCATION: Tract situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section  
2, Township 37 South, Range 4 West, Willamette  
Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the tract of land as  
indicated on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: The right of way of the Left Fork Footh Creek  
(County Road) was located as per Recorded Survey No. 1839, (iron  
pipes found as shown). The 3/4 inch iron pipe found within the  
County Road and South 66° 09' 00" West 12.12 feet from the Southwest  
Corner of the tract and the found iron axle were used to determine  
the southerly line of the tract, these monuments have been considered  
being situated on the tract boundary for many years, and agrees with  
the description distance and bearing between Post 4 and Post 5 as  
noted in the Land Sale Contract, filed as No. 6601006, within reasonable  
limits. Basis of bearings--Recorded Survey No. 3347.
