

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: City of Central Point  
 City Hall  
 Central Point, Oregon

PURPOSE: To reference existing street centerline locations prior to paving and to re-monument same after construction.

PROCEDURE: It has been the policy of the City since 1960, that existing street centers found on the preliminary street construction survey be referenced and then re-monumented by this office after paving. In August of 1967, a field inspection was made of this re-monumentation, so that these controls established by this office are made a matter of record. The monuments referred to as "mon" are 2" bronze disks set in concrete, and pins are 5/8" in diameter set approximately flush with the pavement.
