

Survey Narrative To Comply With Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

LOCATION:

Tract situated in the North One Half (1/2) of Section 16, Township 40 South, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:


To monument the corners and describe the tract

as shown on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: The tract involved was to be bounded by the survey line on the Westerly side, the northerly right of way line of the Old Pacific Highway on the South and the southerly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad on the North. The existing traveled centerline was used to determine the highway right of way line and the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks was used for control due to the lack of monumented control. The title for the tract lying between the survey line and the railroad right of way appears to be in question, therefor, it was not included in this survey, but was described separately and a suit to quiet the title is in process.

The Quarter Section Corner between Section 16 and 21 above
Township and Range was located at a found 1 1/2 inch galvonized iron
pipe and a scribed 18 inch White Oak Tree as indicated on the map.
Basis of bearings--Solar Observation.
