Survey Narrative To Comply With Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR:

Ralph E. Rutherford 455 N. Oregon Street Jacksonville, Oregon

LOCATION:

Tract situated in the Southwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 37 South, Range 2 West Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To partition into lots and blocks the parcel of land as delineated and described on the plat of Gold Mine Subdivision, Unit No.1.

PROCEDURE: The controls established by Recorded Survey No. 2002 were found and used to position the North Line of the Sub-division. Reference is made to the comment in the narrative that the monument set for the initial point of First Addition to the Jacksonville Cemetary being a l 1/4 inch iron pin is in a different position than the Southwest Corner of the Valley View Subdivision which is a 5/8 inch iron pin because in addition to the two pins referred to above there is an additional 5/8 inch iron pin in approximately the same location. By traversing from the Northwest Corner of Donation Land Claim No.37 it was determined that the most Westerly 5/8 inch iron pin or the nearest 5/8 inch iron pin to the 1 1/4 inch iron pin was the one established by Recorded Survey No.2002 for the Southwest Corner of the VALLEY VIEW ADDITION. The alinement of the Southerly line of Recorded Survey No.1958 was used to establish the Northwesterly course of the subdivision appearing as "North 80° 26' 30" East 125.75 feet." The center line of Oregon Street was established by the controls indicated by Recorded Survey No.1958 or more specifically the center line inter-section monument at California and Oregon Street and a point 30.00 feet at right angles from the Southeast Corner of the Easterly tract monumented by Recorded Survey No. 2002. It is proposed by the client to obtain a quit claim deed from the City of Jacksonville to the entire tract described on the plat of the Gold Mine Subdivision, Unit No.1 to clear title to any defects involving the City of Jacksonville.
