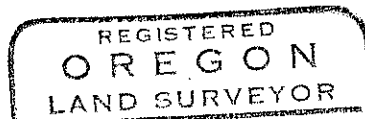
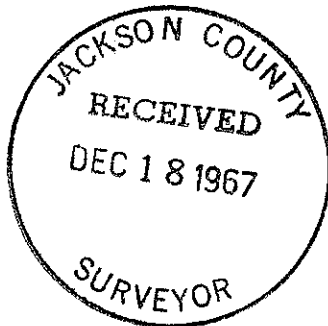
PURPOSE : To separate the tract shown from the parent tract described in D.R.

BEARING : Meridian based on government record for the south boundary of Section 28.

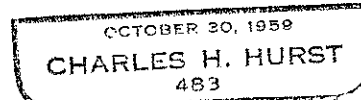
PROCEDURE

Inasmuch as the centerline of Willow Spring Road is described as coincident with the south boundary of Section 28 and the location for the south quarter corner and southeast section corner of said Section have not been preserved; the line between the southwest corner of Section 28 and the northeast corner of D.L.C. 60, set on the section line according to government record, was held for section line control.

Corner pins were set at right angles to said line as shown on the attached plat.
