

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209-250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Purpose :

To establish the location of Oak Gulch as shown on the attached plat, said location heretofore not specifically defined by deed.

Bearing :

Based on meridian established by solar observation September 19, 1967.

PROCEDURE

Approximate center line of Oak Gulch was determined by reference to an offset line established by 50 foot offsets from critical angle points along the course of said gulch.

The southwest corner of recorded survey # 1324 was tied into this survey for reference only and is not to be construed as an endorsement of the true location of the northeast 1/16 corner of Section 4.

A $l_{\rm Z}^{\rm ln}$ X48" iron pipe was set for the north quarter corner of Section 4 by reference to original G.L.O. field notes, i.e. a black oak with scribing intact bearing N 73° W 33.66 feet and a black oak snag with scribing intact bearing S 4° E 18.48 feet. At site of corner monument was remains of a squared oak post decayed flush with ground.
