

Survey Narrative To Comply With Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR:

George W. Oachs Route 4, Box 429E Coleman Creek Road

Talent, Oregon

LOCATION:

Tract situated in the Southeast One Quarter (1/4) of Section 21, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To monument the corners and describe the tract of land as delineated on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: The Jackson County Road Records were used to establish the center lines of Clover & Adams Roads. The monumented P.I.'s at Stations 62 + 60.5 and 84 + 48.5 were found and the $1 exttt{"} ext{ x 2"} ext{ stake with tack was found to be 0.20 of being on line and}$ also on the southerly line of Adams Road (Jackson County Road Station 72 + 53.9), this alinement was used because it conformed to the monuments found. An alinement revision was contemplated on this tangent according to the field notes, although the County Engineer advised that neither alinement was definite at this time. The record angle shown on the County Road Map for Clover Lane was used in conjunction with the stake to determine the alinement of Adams Road.

We were advised by the Talent Irrigation District Office to establish a line 25.00 feet in distant from and parallel to the existing canal center line for the right of way line.

The record description for the parcel conflicted with the description of adjacent tracts, so the existing boundary line was monumented and the client is to obtain boundary line agreements to the descriptions prepared for the separate ownerships. Basis of bearings--County Road Records.
