

FURPOSE:

To monument the Tract described in O.R.

66-09648 of the Deed Records of Jackson

County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

The monumented highway Right of Way was used as control for the East Boundary of this Tract. Tie from the corner common to Donation Land Claim No.'s 70, 71, 72, 73, to the 5/8 inch iron pin at highway Station 157.11.1 as shown on Recorded Survey No. 2961 was also used in this survey. Using the above mentioned data it became evident that retracing the deed description for this Tract would create gaps and overlaps with existing occupancy, possibly due in part to a protraction of previous deeds. The location of the existing fences as shown on the accompaning plat substantially agrees with the location of said fences as shown on Oregon State Highway Map No. 5B-7-22 which shows the location and ties to the fences prior to highway construction. These fences better fit the intent of older deeds and were therefore used in this survey as control. Distances were proportioned along the fence line shown on the accompaning map as the Easterly Boundary of Volume 112, Page 339 in determining the location of the corners described in O.R. 66-09648.

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
