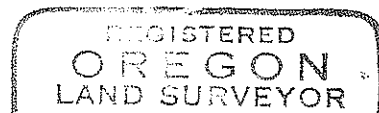
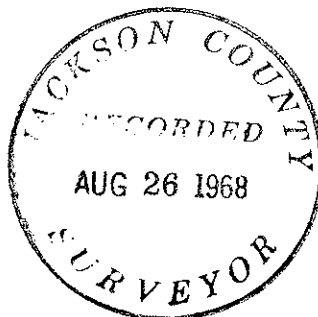
Surveyed over an existing road, also a proposed change of a portion, on the northerly portion, of Offenbacher property and across the Bryden property to the end of the course N. 2° 21' 40" E., 299.06 ft.

There has been some question as to the legal status of egress and ingress to the Southeast 1/4 of Sec. 19, T38S, R3W.

In the event this survey of a proposed road location is in agreement with the interested parties, I have prepared this map so as to assist or eliminate any problems which may arise in the future.

Monuments set being at angle points on PI of curves, being railroad spikes or 40 penny spikes or 1/2 in. iron pins, 6 to 12 inches long, set approx. flush with the surface.
