Northeast corner of Section 20 found a 2 in. iron pipe, approx. flush with the surface.

Southwest corner and Northwest corner of the South half of the Northeast quarter, found a 5/8 in. iron pin, approx. flush with the surface being of recorded survey No. 3736.

Gounty road P.I. 290 + 01.30, found remains of hub, set a 5/8 in. X 14 in. re-bar.

County road P.C. 300+80.47, set a boat spike, flush with the pavement, from County road referance.

County road PT. 311+58.22, found nail, 4 ins. deep.

Station 0+00, Long Branch Road determined referance tie to County road PT 311+58.22.
