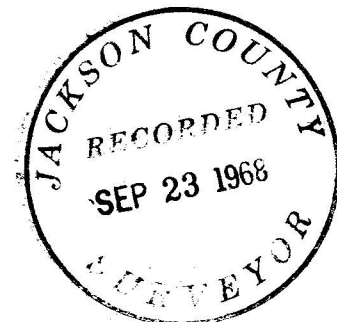

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the tract as shown
 on accompanying map.

PROCEDURE: The Westerly Line of this tract was established
 by projecting the East Line of Irish Lane North
 from Recorded Survey No. 3747. The Easterly
 line was established by following a line 30 feet
 from and parallel to the existing Talent Irrig-
 ation District Canal centerline. The South-
 erly line was established in recorded Survey No.
 3747. The Northerly line of this tract was es-
 tablished by projecting a line parallel to and
 10' Southerly (measured at right angles to) of
 the South boundary of Butler Creek County Road
 Easterly from the monuments of Recorded Survey
 No. 2641.
