
## Survey For PAUL RENEAU SEC.26835,T38S,RJW,WM. JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON AUGUST 9, 1968



## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR:

Paul Reneau Rapp Lane Talent, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a 120.0 % 230.0 foot parcel adjacent to Rapp Lane, and prepare a legal description.

PROCEDURE:

Traversed between the S.E. Corner of D.L.C. 65 and the N.E. Corner of D.L.C. 67, setting a 5" iron pin on the D.L.C. line, 650.5 feet west of the S.E. Corner of D.L.C. 65 to establish the center-line of Rapp Lane as described in Deed Records Volume 97, page 314. Traversed along said center-line, as shown on the accompanying Plat, monumenting the aforementioned parcel with 5" iron pins. Bearings based on the Deed Record for the D.L.C. line, the same procedure followed in Recorded Survey No. 1953.
