


Survey six acre parcel to follow existing Logging road and set pins at all corners. Purpose:

The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, T 37 S. R 4 W., W.M, Jackson County, Oregon Location:

Found 3/4" Iron Pipe and scribed bearing trees at the East quarter corner of Section 15 per Procedure:

survey # 934. Traversed south and west to the intersection of Foots Creek Road and a B.L.M. logging road; traversed the road and set pins

at property corners as shown on map.

Bearings by solar observation.

The pon at the northwest corner of the intersection is approximately 20' from the apparent centerline of Foots Creek Road; however there is a large clear area and a turn around which makes is difficult to locate the centerline exactly(the road is unimproved).
