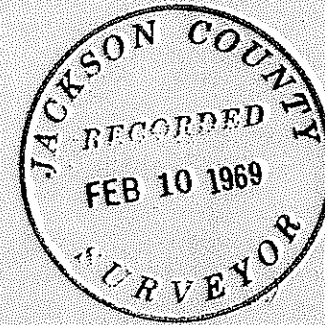

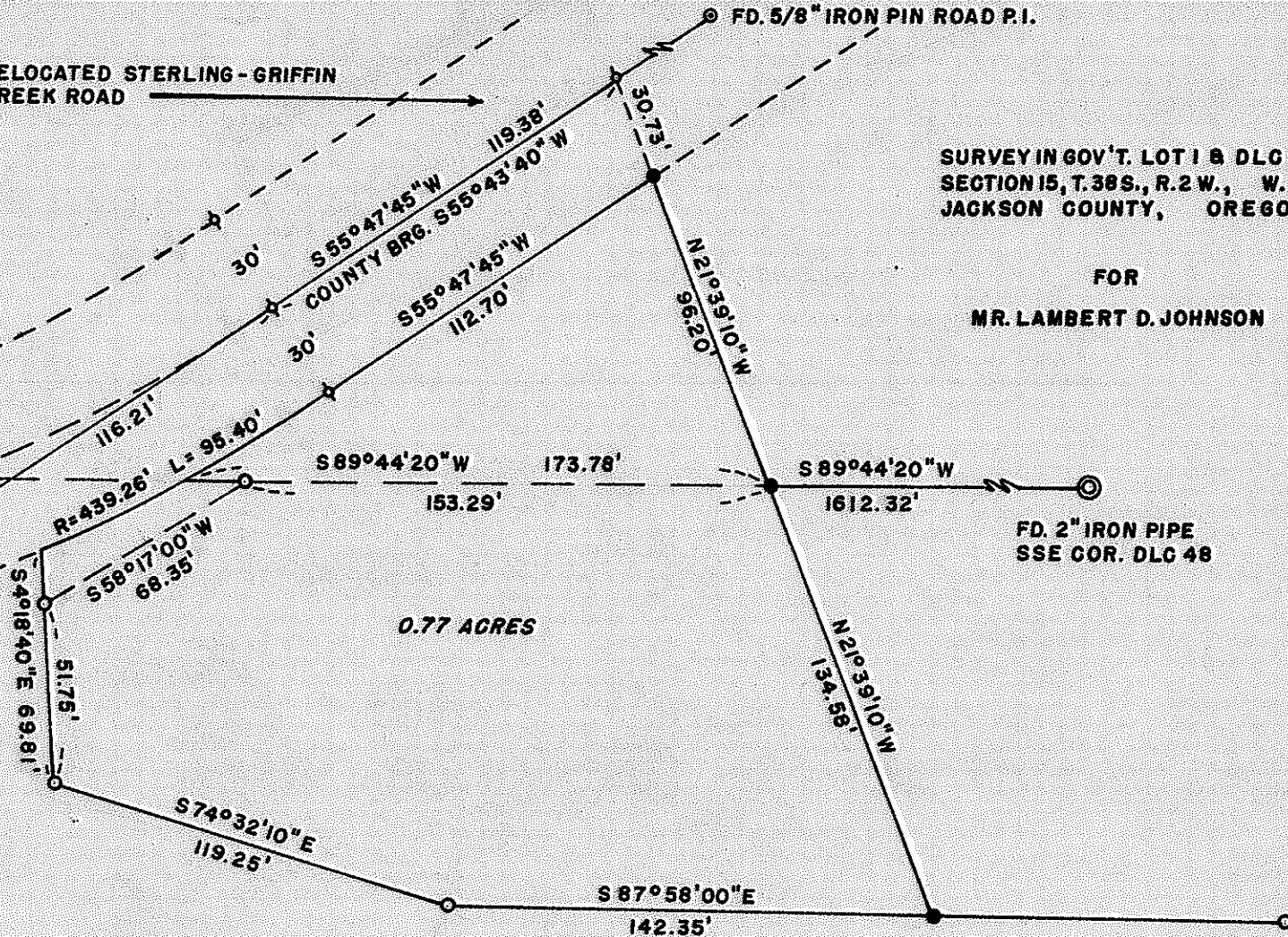

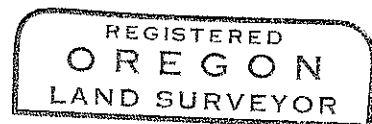
Procedure

Survey was based on control previously established during the course of recorded survey No. 2798.

Monuments controlling the relocated center line of the Sterling-Griffin Creek Road were held for purposes of determining the right-of-way boundary.

That tract separated as shown by recorded survey No. 2798 was intended to abut the southerly boundary of the county road. Accordingly, said monuments are considered closing corners thereto and the additional footage required to close against the right-of-way is shown.
