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the true centerline of Section 36, the client was informed of the situation and supplied with a description of same for establishing the line by agreement with the adjoiner.

The Southern Pacific Company Railroad right of way lines were established 50 feet and parallel to the existing centerline of their tracks.

The Colestine Road centerline was established by averaging the existing roadway width. It is the intent of the client to deed this 60' wide strip to the county, therefore a centerline description for the road was furnished client.

PROCEDURE:

Bearings were obtained from averaging four solar obsrvations taken at approximately 3:00 p.m. on the two different days with a 20" transit, taking three direct and three reverse each set, near the Northeast corner of Section 36. Probable error of computed bearing equals plus or minus 30". The North line of Section 36 was established according to the monuments established by the Bureau of Land Management. The East line of Section 36 was established between the West quarter corner of Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 2, East, and the Northwest corner of Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 2 East, from which the North line of Section 36 was intersected with for the true corner of Section 36, Township 40 South, Range 1 East. The South quarter corner of Section 36, Township 40 South, Range 1 East, is lost and due to economy the line established Southerly from the North quarter corner of Sec. 36 was run on a line intercepting a fence corner at a point that appears to be near the location of the quarter corner.
