

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963.

FOR:

Chester Pullman Route 1, Box 304 Gold Hill, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a parcel, as directed by client, and prepare a metes and bounds legal description.

PROCEDURE:

This tract had been recently conveyed by a fractional subdivision of a Section description, which made the cost of surveying almost prohibitive. The surveyor suggested that essentially the same parcel be reconveyed, using a metes and bounds description based on an accurate survey. This was agreed to by grantee and grantor, and the parcel was surveyed accordingly. At the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between sections 14 and 15, found a  $\frac{3n}{4}$  iron pipe, from which bear the following:

White Oak, S 73°05' W 42.51 feet Scribing and chaining notch visible.

Black Oak S 85°56' E 17.23 feet Face, but no scribing visible.

At the corner common to Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23, found a 1" iron pipe with stemped brass cap, as reestablished in 1960.

5" iron pins were set at apparent Road P.I.'s, as shown on accompanying Plat.
