

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR:

Karl Windbigler 1929 Verda Street Ashland, Oregon

LOCATION:

Lots 2 and 14, Block 5, TIMBER LINE SUBDIVISION situated in Section 15, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, in the city of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To monument the parcels as shown on the attached map per clients instructions.

PROCEDURE:

Found crimped pipe at the lot corners as shown. From these monuments a control net was established to set the remaining lot corners.

In checking the mathematical closure of Deed Record No. 68-11288, I find it to be in error. The East boundary line of said Deed Record, calls for 60.46 feet. When checking the distance between the Northeast corner of Lot 14, Block 5 of said subdivision, and the Northwest corner of Deed Record No. 66-01017, a distance of 60.76 feet results. Applying this distance in place of the 60.46 feet, a satisfactory mathematical closure is obtained. Therefore, I believe it was the intent that the Northerly boundary of said Deed Record should terminate at the Northwest corner of Deed Record No. 66-01017, which was executed prior to Deed Record No. 68-11288.
