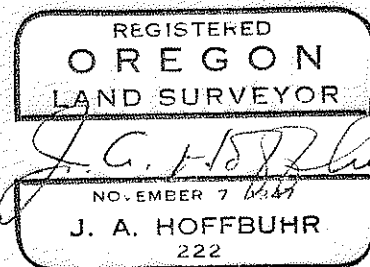
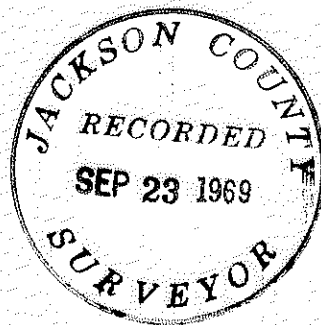
LOCATION: Tract situate in the East One Half (1/2) of Section 16 and the Northeast One Quarter (1/4) of the Northeast One Quarter (1/4) of Section 21, Township 40 South, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To create roads and subdivide into tracts the land shown on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: The entire tract was originally joined by the tracts to the North-East and South under one ownership. This meadow portion was separated from the timber land by Surveyor Lowell Ager, deceased, but there is no record of his survey. Mr. Clint Wynn, Forester for J. H. Baxter & Co. was personally familiar with the details of the survey, therefore, by holding Agers bearings and by orientation, the lines were replaced to satisfy both parties and boundary line agreements obtained on all sides excepting the portion of the line along the Southern Pacific Railroad right of way and the Oregon State Highway Department right of way. The tract was then partitioned as shown.
