Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250  
Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR: C. R. Eliason  
128 Wimer Street  
Ashland, Oregon

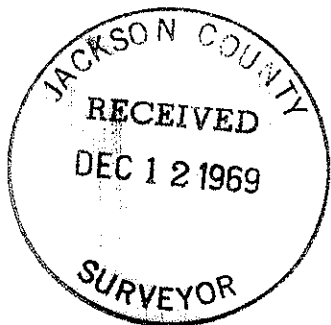
LOCATION: Situated in Government Lot 4, Section 5, Township  
39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and  
Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument the remaining portion of Deed  
Records Volume 260, Page 252 and Volume 269, Page 414  
per clients request.

PROCEDURE: Commenced this survey at the Northwest corner of  
Government Lot 4, Section 5, said Township and Range,  
said point being monumented with a 1 inch iron bar  
as set by the Ashland City Surveyor, Mc Call in  
approximately 1888. Traversed along the centerline  
of Wimer Street to a 1 inch iron bar at Rock and  
Wimer Street. Continued along the centerline of  
Wimer to a 1 inch square iron bar at Wimer and High  
(Lower Almond) Street. The traverse was continued  
Southerly along High Street to a 1 inch square iron  
bar as set by Mc Call for the intersection of the West  
boundary of D.L.C. No. 40 and the centerline of an  
alley West. From the found 1 inch iron bar which  
controls the alley, West of High Street, the record  
bearing of South 89°54' West was held to position  
the centerline of said alley. The existing improvements  
check very well with relation to the established  
centerline for said alley. The centerline of said  
alley was intersected with the West boundary of  
Government Lot 4, Section 5, said Township and Range.  
With this information the remaining portion of  
Volume 260, Page 252 and Volume 269, Page 414 of the  
Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon were ascertained  
as shown on the accompanying map.
