LOCATION:

Tract situated in the Southwest One Quarter (1/4) of Section 19, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To subdivide into Lots, the tract of land described and delineated on the plat of

Applegate Park Subdivision.

PROCEDURE: The tract is bounded on the West by the East Bank of the Applegate River and on the East by the Westerly right of way line of the Applegate Road. The Jackson County Engineers centerline control for the Applegate Road was relocated and used. An agreement with Jackson County resulted in the conveyance of the present 60.00 foot road in addition to a 20.00 foot strip lying parallel and adjacent to the above road line.

An attempt was made to locate the original rocks placed on the corners of the original Mining Claim No. 37, but were unable to locate them. I met with the U. S. Forest Service regarding the placement of the river bank line. It was agreed that the line surveyed for the West line of the subdivision would be considered as the line referred to in the description of the Mining Claim. This description does not close mathematically, also by plotting the coordinates computed using the Mining Claim's description of the bank line, a portion of the line falls on the West side of the river, there is no indication that the river has changed its location in the past 100 years.

The line established for the North line of the subdivision has been positioned to avoid a conflict with the adjoining tract to the North as recorded in Record of Survey No. 1257 by Surveyor, L. P. Lovejoy.

Basis of bearings--Oregon State Coordinate System corrected to local bearings as shown by the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers on the survey control for the Applegate Dam.
