

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963.

FOR:

Joseph Hennick 1523 Ashland Mine Road Ashland, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a residential parcel.

PROCEDURE:

Surveyor Ager had done considerable work in the area, including Recorded Survey No. 3621, PLEASANT VIEW SUBDIVISION, and various unrecorded surveys. An examination of these surveys, and the various legal descriptions of the area, indicated an apparent intent for the parcel to be 112.04 feet from the westerly line of Lot 4, said SUBDIVISION. The line in question was found to have been monumented as shown, and the parcel was further monumented as indicated on the accompanying Plat.

A survey tie was made to the $l^{1n}_{\mathbb{Z}}$ pipe referred to by Ager as the section corner.

Due to the questionable status of this section corner, and the fact Ashland Mine Road, as monumented by various surveys, recorded and unrecorded, does not correspond to the original Road record, a Boundary Line Agreement is recommended for the easterly line of said parcel.
