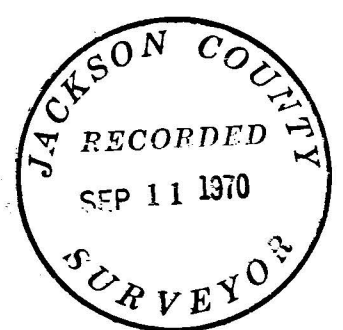


### MAP OF SURVEY

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250  
Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR: Albert E. Bamforth  
132 North Main  
Ashland, Oregon

LOCATION: Situated in Lot 7 and 8, Block 5, in the "Original  
Town of Ashland" and Donation Land Claim No. 40,  
Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette  
Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument a tract of land per description provided  
by the client.

PROCEDURE: Commenced this survey at the intersection of Helman  
Street and Central Avenue. Traversed Northwesterly  
along Central Avenue to North Main. Thence Southeasterly  
along North Main to Helman Street. Thence Northeasterly  
along Helman Street to Central Avenue. All monuments  
shown were recovered per the intersection tie notes on  
record with the office of the "City Engineer" Ashland,  
Oregon. From the following information, monumented  
the tract as shown on the accompanying map.

This survey was performed with a Model 6A Geodimeter,  
Invar Sub-Tense Bar and Wild T-2 Theodolite, all in  
good adjustment.
