

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Situated in Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To establish a division line between property sold and the remainder of the original tract.

PROCEDUKE:

The client was advised the fence lines in the vicinity of this survey does not necessarily represent the true section lines and the boundaries would be subject to change at such time as the Southeast corner of Section 19 was established. The client informed me he had sold the property on the basis that the existing East and South fences were the property boundaries. He requested these fences be held for control.

From survey control previously established by this office, proceeded Northerly along the Westerly boundary of Recorded Survey No. 3141, record distance of 485.69 feet and set a 5/8 inch iron pin; proceeded Westerly and parallel to the North boundary of kecorded Survey No. 2360, a distance of 871.40 feet and set a 5/8 inch iron pin for a witness corner.
