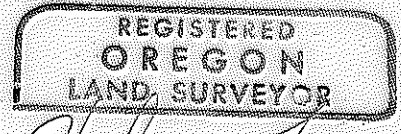
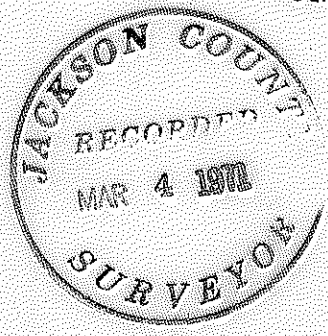
Mc Call's 1888 Bearing for

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250  
REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O. L. 1963

FOR: BOB VORIS  
1545 Highway 99 South  
Ashland, Oregon

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a residential parcel on Oak Street,  
Ashland, according to legal description.

PROCEDURE: Recovered the stone at Oak and Hersey Streets and a square  
iron pin, both established by surveyor, M. L. McCall in 1888.  
A geodimeter traverse was then conducted from the Brass cap  
monument at the reestablished Southwest corner of D.L.C. 41,  
to that certain 2" iron pipe presently accepted as being the  
Northeast corner of D.L.C. 40. The parcel was then monumented  
as described, the southerly line being also the southerly line  
of parcel described in Deed Records Volume 141, Page 569.
