

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

PURPOSE:

To partition the tract as shown on the accompaning

map.

PROCEDURE:

The centerline of Old Highway 99 was established as was in Recorded Survey No. 4126 by adopting the

mean measurement of the existing pavement.

The Northerly and the Southerly Boundary of the overall tract was established along the present fence lines and finalized by agreement (see Doc. 71-06740 O.R., J.C.,O.) as the record location was

economically unfeasable to undertake.

The Southerly Right of Way of Highway 66 was established according to the O.S.H.D. monuments found. The monuments found along the Westerly line of the tract described in Doc. 67-09570 O.R., J.C.,O. were originally established by Surveyor L.E. Ager in 1966 (survey unfecorded). The monuments set by me at the Northerly and Southerly terminus of this at the Northerly and Southerly terminus of this line were established according to L.E. Agers original control, the field notes of which are in

my possession.
