

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR: Paul G. Schaffran

Highway 99 Talent, Oregon

LOCATION:

Situated in Donation Land Claim No. 72, Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 1 West and Donation Land Claim No. 41, Section 30, Township 38 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian. Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument two tracts of land per descriptions furnished by the client.

PROCEDURE:

Commenced this survey from previously established survey control. See Recorded Survey No. 4457. A random traverse was run encompassing said tracts of land. All monuments that could be found were tied into this survey control. In reviewing recorded surveys No. 45, 53, 1103 and 3372 it was apparent these surveys were not in harmony with one another. In reviewing the "Deeds of Record" for the various adjoining propertys, there were other values found for these property lines which did not correspond with the aforementioned recorded surveys.

A study of the chain of title was undertaken. After reviewing the many conveyences, the title company was consulted in regard to their view of the controlling calls for these tracts of land. It was felt the proper solution was to establish equitable boundaries between all land owners on the West and South sides and acquire boundary line agreements. See accompanying map. However, the Southeasterly and a portion of the Southwesterly boundary of the Alfred G. Schaffran tract does not require boundary line agreements. In fact there is a gap between the Southwesterly boundary of Volume 306, Page 219 and the Northeasterly boundary of Instrument No. 67-12148.

Between the Paul Schaffran and Alfred Schaffran property lies a tract described in Instrument No. 69-03090 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. When computing the location of this tract in relation to the Schaffran tracts, a strip of land is found to still remain in the ownership of Mrs. Charles D. Rice (since remarried). See Volume 306, Page 219 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. This condition will be corrected by additional conveyences. additional conveyences.
