Precedence of Survey:

From data of previous survey for Larry Rich and theorectical subdivision of Section, determined the northerly line of Tract.

The Easterly line of tract was determined by a combination of data, deed records and apparent intent to be parallel to the East line of Section.

The southerly line, as surveyed, was ran parallel to the South line of the Section. The most of deed calls are west which would indicate the tracts lying to the south would over-lap in the now existing right of way of the county road.

The westerly line, as surveyed, was ran North by solar observation. Ax Most all deed calls indicate north on the property adjacent.
