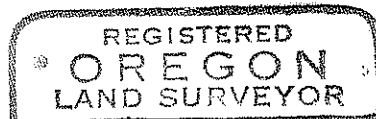

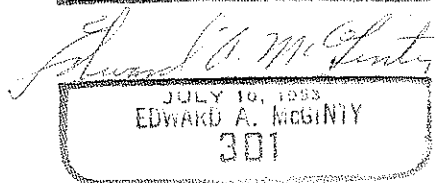

Basis of Bearing: Solar observation

Location: NW 1/4 Cor. Sec. 1, N 1/2 of Sec. 2, T35S, R4W and Section line between 35 and 36, T34S, R4W

Precedence of Survey:

1/4 Cor. betwn. Secs. 2/3 , found a 1/2 in. iron pipe approx. 4 ft. long driven in square post in center of rock mound. Replaced pipe with a 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pin with 1 1/4 in. B. Cap driven approx. flush from which:

Orig. BT., now a badly burned pine snag with old axe marks visible, bears N.82°07'E., 84 ft. to face. (Note: NW. found indentation in earth and ashes)

- Madrona, 8" diam., bears S.23°41'E., 34.1 ft., mkd 1/4 S BT.
- Madrona, 8" diam., bears S.40°W., 28.8 ft., mkd 1/4 S. BT.

Corner Secs. 2/3 T35S, R4W and Secs. 34/35, T34S, R4W, found a 1 in. pipe and 2 in. B.C. approx. flush in small ravine from which:

- A Pine snag, 32" diam., bears S.42°W., 66.5 ft.
- Fir, 9" diam., bears S.68°11'W., 61.8 ft.
- B. Oak, 15" diam., bears N.40°39'W., 30.75 ft.
- Fir, 12" diam., bears N.23°35'E., 45.9 ft.
- B. Oak, 4" diam., bears S.50°39'E., 36.4 ft.

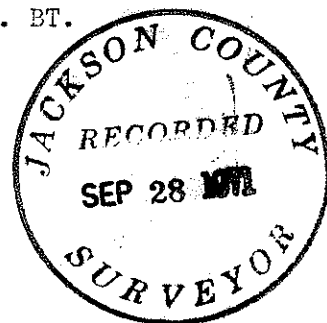

- Fir, 9" diam., bears S.39°13'W., 35.5 ft., mkd. BT.
- Fir, 3" diam., bears N.71°12'E., 22.8 ft., mkd. BT.
- Sprouts and Stump hole, probable original BT bears S. 20°00'E., 39.6 ft.

E. 1/16 Corner betw. Sec. 35, T34S, R4W & Sec. 2, T35S, R4W, set a 5/8 x 24 in. iron pin and B. Cap from which:

- Madrona , 6" diam., bears N.23°16'W., 31.94 ft. mkd. BT.
- B. Oak, 22" diam., bears S. 38° W., 10.1 ft., mkd. BT.

1/4 Cor. - Secs. 1 & 2 found post along side and evidence of post hole in small rock mound, set a 5/8 x 24 in. iron pin, from which

Orig. BT., a downed snag (B.Oak) 16 ins. diam., with reverse scribe, bears S.29°00"E., 13.20 ft.

Orig. BT., a burned pine snag, bears N.68°00' W., 29.38 ft., instead of 28.38 ft.

1/4 Corner betw. Section 36, T34S, R4W and Section 1, T35S, R4W found a post hole indentation. Set 5/8 x 24 in. iron pin, from which

Orig. BT, now a stump, bears N.5°E., 4.6 ft.

County Surveyors BT, now a fir stump, 27 ins. diam., bears S.2°11'E., (Rec. S.4 1/2°E) 18.7 ft. to face of blaze. BT visible.

Orig. BT, SW falls in old ditch

Orig. BT, NW, falls where tractor worked

Orig. BT, NE, falls where tailings of mining

Creek ties to the West and to bed of old creek to the south are in agreement with calls. Found center of stump hole of line tree, N.0°01'03"W., 380.5 ft. (Call to tree North 379.5 ft.) Rock mound approx. 15 yrs. old with laurel post, bears

MX South 39°40'West, 4.7 ft.

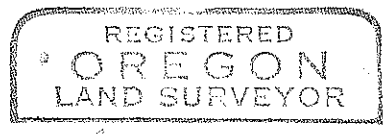

- A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.17°11'E., 23.2 ft. mkd. BT
- B. Oak, 3 ins. diam., bears S.37°11'E., 21.5 ft. mkd. BT

Corner of Secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36 found BLM standard 2 1/2 in. pipe with brass disc. (replacing co. sur. 2 in. pipewhich now sets along the Northerly side), from which

Precedence of Survey:

On March 3, 1977, the county surveyors office re-established the North one quarter corner of Sec. 2, T35S, R4W., WM by recovering a reverse scribe 1/4 S on an original tree, now a hollow laurel, 20 ins. diam., which bears S.20°E., 39.60 ft. and made to a tie to a traverse point on survey No. 4616, S.79°05'E., 2.35 ft. From this data, recomputed the North line of Sec. 2 as shown.
