

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR:

Willis E. Flanagan 5845 Daneland Ave. Lakewood, Calif.

PURPOSE:

To monument and describe the tracts as shown on the accompaning map.

PROCEDURE:

A random line traverse was run between the Southeast and Northeast corner of Section 3 to establish the true section line. The unrecorded monument found at the East 1/4 corner of Section 3 was accepted for the true corner position in as much as its position looks reasonable by proportional measurement. From this monument at the East 1/4 corner of Section 3, a 40" fir stump with a blaze chopped out (no scribing found) bears South 15° East 33.7 feet to the center of stump. Four apparently old hack marks were found on the bark of this tree arranged in a square on a portion of the tree trunk (now lying on the ground) approximately breast high. No evidence was found of the original Southwest bearing tree. As no monuments were available for the Right of Way control of Green Springs Highway, the existing centerline was adopted. The remaining tract boundaries were established according to clients

instructions.
