SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH 0.R.S. 209.250, REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, 0.L. 1963

PURPOSE - To rehabilitate and perpetuate the one quarter section corner common to Sections 23 and 24, Township 32 South, Range | West, Willamette Meridian.

PROCEDURE - Found 1" iron pipe from which a 15" Douglas fir bears South 34° West a distance of 18.0° upper and lower faces closed and a 12" Douglas fir with closed faces which was knocked down by logging operations the stump hole of which bears North 74° East a distance of 5.9 feet. This agrees with Mark Boyden's 1955 establishment of the corner.

NEW REFERENCES - From the 1" iron pipe a 12" Douglas fir bears North 69^{10}_2 East a distance of 26.7° scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 in the upper face and BT in the lower face. The distance to the new bearing tree was measured to the face of the blaze and compass variation was set at 20° 00° East.
