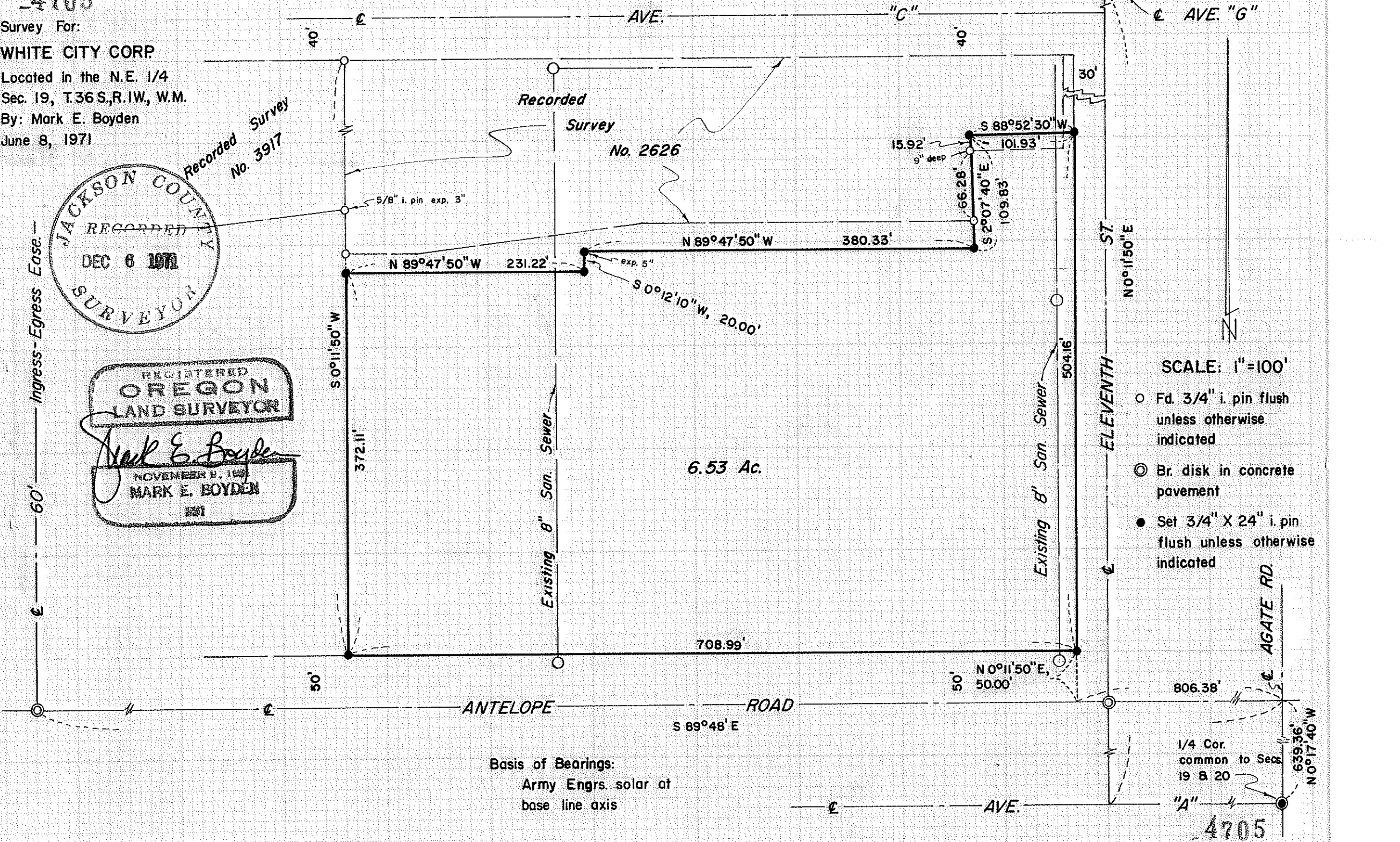
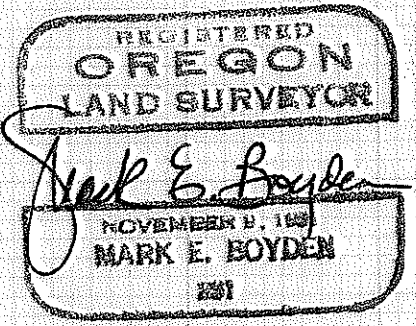
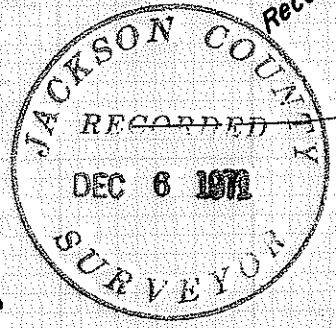

- PURPOSE:
1. To monument and describe an industrial tract proposed to be conveyed.
  2. To prepare a new description of the American Bitumuls Tract (see Recorded Survey No. 2626) to conform with the most-Northerly North boundary of the tract monumented on this survey.
