SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To rehabilitate and perpetuate the 1/4 corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 31 South, Range 2 East W.M.

PROCEDURE: Found a cedar stump with visible scribe. No evidence of the other bearing tree or the original stone. At the record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree set a $1'' \times 36''$ galvanized iron pipe, 30'' in the ground, capped with a $1\frac{1}{2}''$ to 1'' bell reducer filled with pot metal and stamped as shown below:

From which a 15" cedar bears N $51\frac{10}{2}$ E a distance of 141.1 feet scribed 1/4 S 12 - BT and a 10" Douglas fir bears S 49^{0} E a distance of 72.7 feet scribed 1/4 S 13 - BT.

All distances and bearings were taken to the face of the upper blaze. Magnetic declination was set at $18^{\rm O}$ 30 Least to agree with a solar observation taken nearby.
