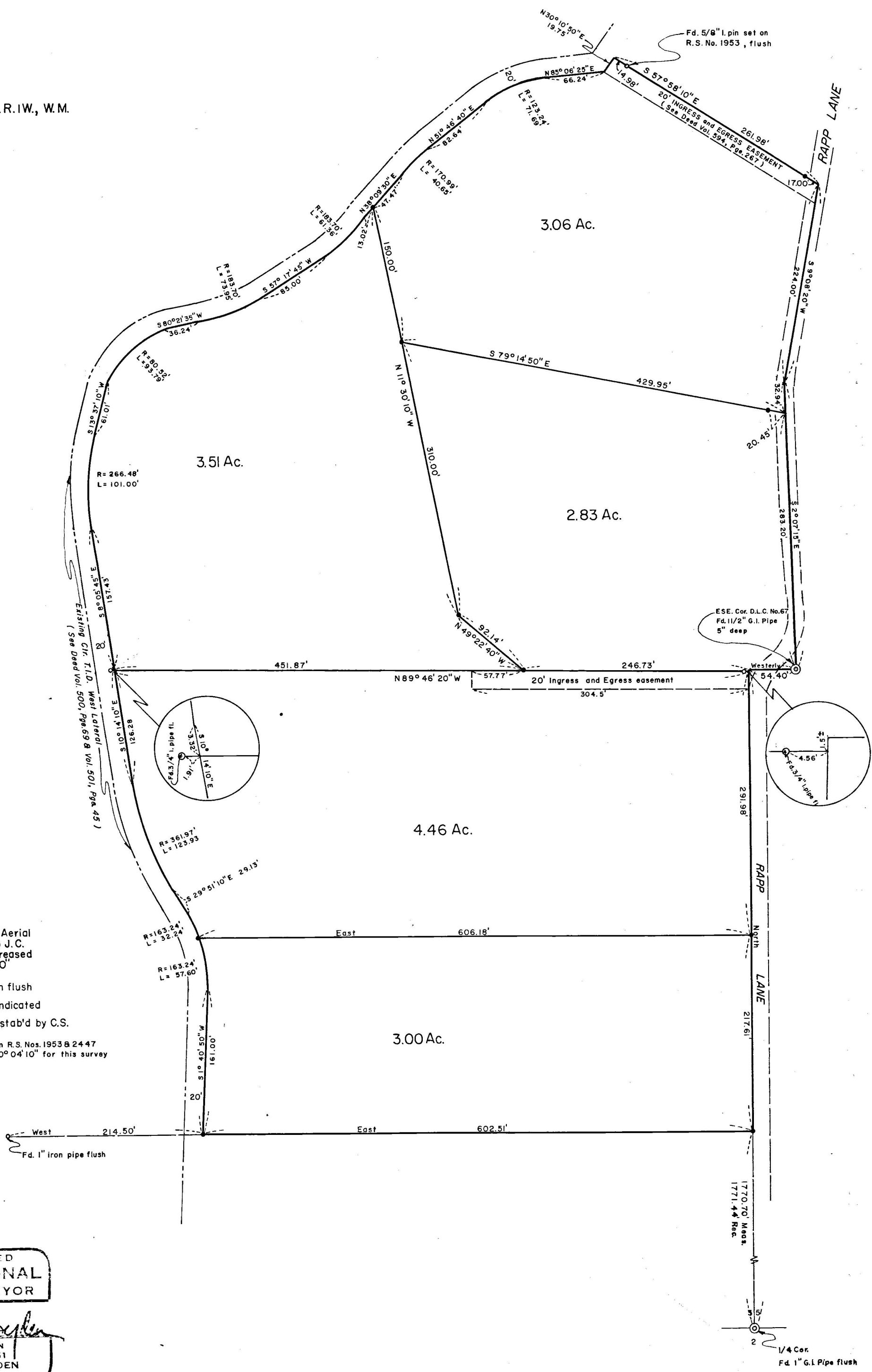

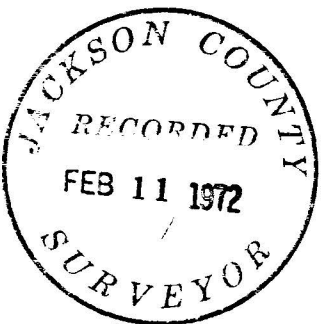

Grid bearing of line from Aerial Mapping Co. sta. T-106 to J.C. Tria. sta. Cascade decreased in Azimuth by $\theta=01^{\circ} 34' 00''$

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Fred Kuest
7772 Rapp Lane
Talent, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe in 5 parcels the Kuest ownership described in Instrument No. 67-09704, Official Records and in Instrument No. 68-07265, Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon, being located in Section 35, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing the T2 Theodolite and the HP 3800-A Distance Meter, made ties to controlling monuments and the existing centerline of the Talent Irrigation District's West Lateral.

From said data, computed the corner positions desired and monumented same as shown on the map to accompany this report.
