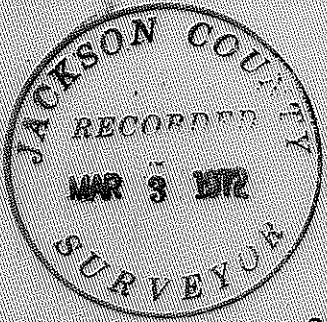


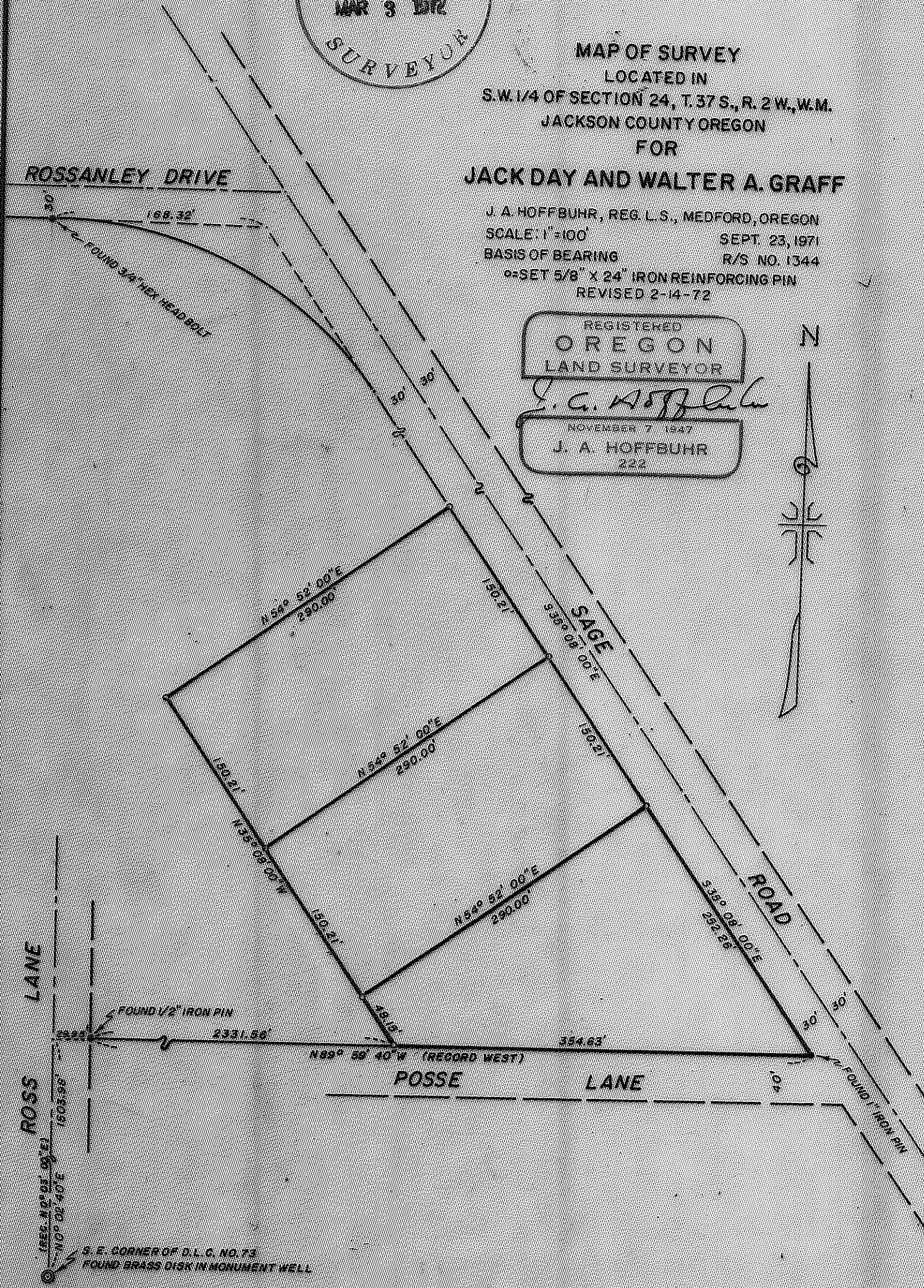
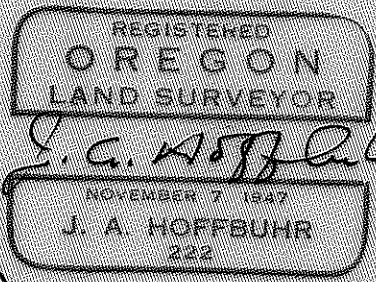

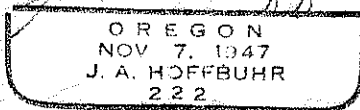
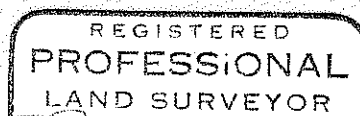
LOCATION: Tract situated in the Southwest One Quarter (1/4)
of Section 24, Township 37 South, Range 2 West,
Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument the boundary and prepare a legal
description of the tract shown.

PROCEDURE: The description of the parcel described in Jackson
County Instrument No. 70-12246 refers to iron pin monuments on
the boundary corners, although there is no evidence of a Record
of Survey for the tract. The property pins were located and
tied. Their positions were found to be within a reasonable
accuracy and were accepted for the perimeter boundary for this
survey. The tract was monumented and described as shown.
