

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L., 1963

PURPOSE:

To monument and describe the partition of the tract as shown on the accompaning map.

PROCEDURE:

The Westerly line of said tract, being the only line monumented by this survey, was established according to clients instruction, from which a traverse was made to the West 1/4 Corner of Sec. 18. The remaining lines of said tract were calculated from record, and therefor must remain more or less at this time. From the 5/8 inch iron pin found at the West 1/4 Corner of Sec. 18, the original bearing trees were found as follows: A 12 inch White Oak stump with two blazes open (no scribing visible) bears North 74° East 19.0 feet to lower face; a 15 inch White Oak Stump with two blazes open (no scribing visible) bears South 44° West 13.9 feet to lower face.
