

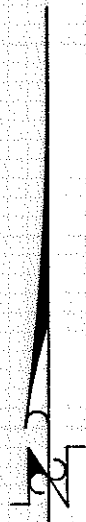

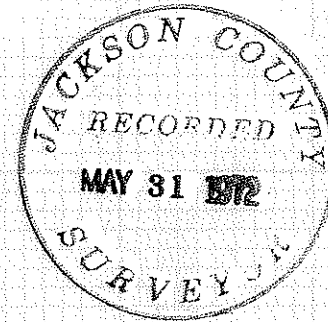
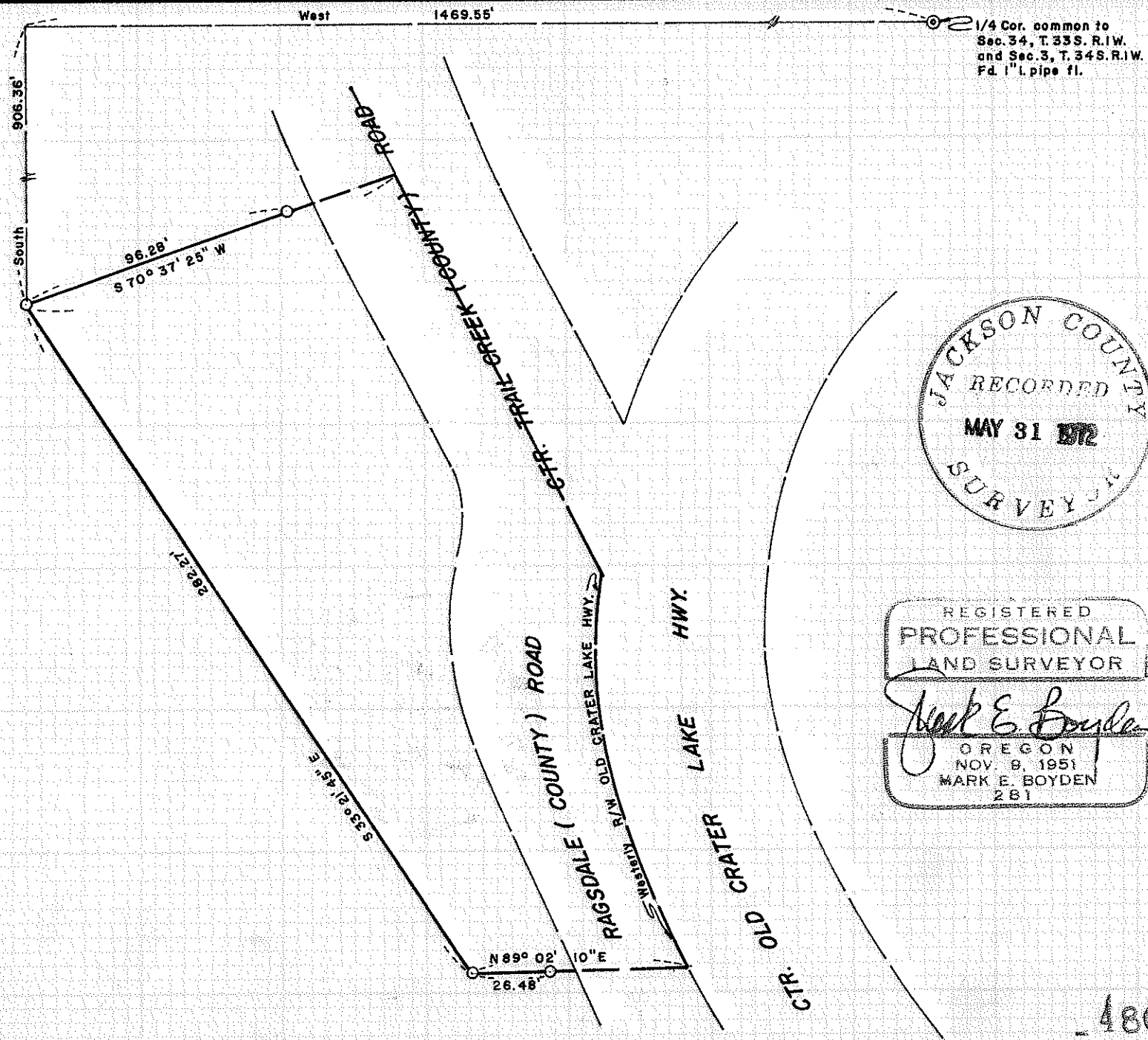

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209,250

FOR: Elizabeth Miller
Trail, Oregon

PURPOSE: To partially monument and fully describe a parcel of land proposed to be conveyed, being located in the NW 1/4 of Section 3, T.34S.R.1W., W. M..

PROCEDURE: Utilizing the T-2 theodolite, the H. P. 3800-A Distance meter and chain, tied to the North Quarter corner of Section 3 and to the improved portions of existing roads near the subject premises. From said data, set monuments at the desired locations as shown on the map to accompany this report.
