

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250

OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Bearing : Based on the meridian for the centerline of Oregon 234.

Purpose : To monument the corners of the tract shown prior to conveyance.

PROCEDURE

In that right-of-way monumentation along the boundary of Oregon 234 varies in distance from centerline, true center was held as being midway between the R/W monuments indicated.

Witness trees referencing the quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 6 do not indicate a common point. A railroad iron was found at the approximate corner position on an E - W fence line from which

A White oak, 20 ins. dia., brs. S 27° E 37.54 ft. to ctr.

A White oak, 17 ins. dia., brs. N 58° W 92.36 ft. to face

(Butt face "BT" in reverse scribe, a hollow snag)

An E - W - N fence intersection brs. W'ly. 76 ft.

A line tree, a White cak, bearing South 4.68 chains per government record was not recovered inasmuch as the client owns on both sides of the section line which precluded the expenditure of additional time obviously required to resolve record discrepancies to determine of said railroad iron should be held as the true quarter corner.

However, line was held to same and the client is advised that the tract separated may later prove to be astride the section line. The Jackson County Surveyor has been requested to investigate this corner and reestablish same.
