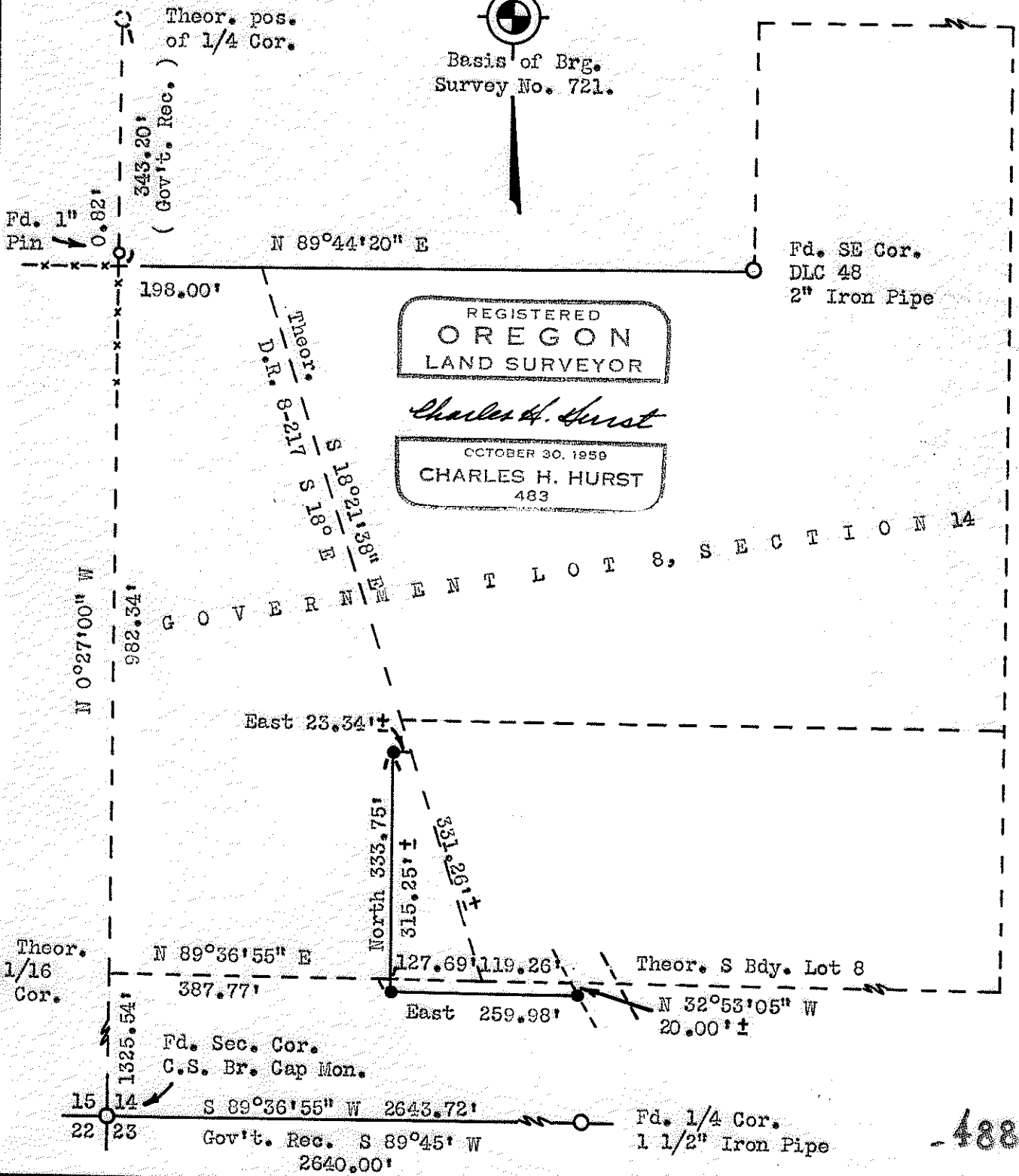

Purpose : To monument the lines shown.

PROCEDURE

In that it was not economically feasible to determine the boundaries of Government Lot 8 at this time, the client desired to determine the approximate location of said lines in order to compensate adjacent owners for land included North and East of the lines as monumented.

Accordingly, the south line of Lot 8 was held parallel with the south boundary of Section 14 and the west boundary was theoretically determined by intersect with the south boundary of DLC 48 holding line through a 1" iron pin of undetermined origin 0.82 feet North of said intersect.

This procedure was utilized in order to determine the approximate boundary of D.R. 8-217 and does not imply precise locations for the south and west boundary of Government Lot 8 or the southwest and west-southwest corners thereof.
