

White oak, 10 ins. diam., bears N.52°10'W., 28.0 ft.

White oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N.40°26'E., 31.0 ft.

White oak, 6 ins. diam., bears S.14°43'W., 11.5 ft. White oak, 9 ins. diam., bears S.83°10'E., not meas.

At the NE. corner of Lot 1, Blk. 3 found a 5/8 in. iron pin.
