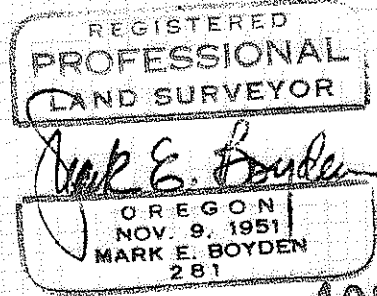
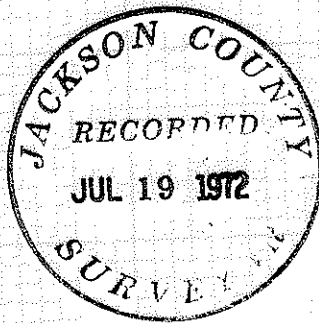

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Jackson County Board of Commissioners  
Courthouse  
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a 2.00-acre parcel located within the Medford-Jackson County Airport property in the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, T37S, R1W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing the T2 Theodolite, the H.P. 3800-A Distance Meter and chain, tied from the concrete monument with brass disk located at the West Quarter Corner of Section 7, through triangulation station "BEACON" and thence to and around the desired parcel. From random controls, then monumented the corners said parcel, utilizing the record bearing of the main runway as reported on Recorded Survey No. 447 to control the direction of the Southwesterly parcel boundary.
