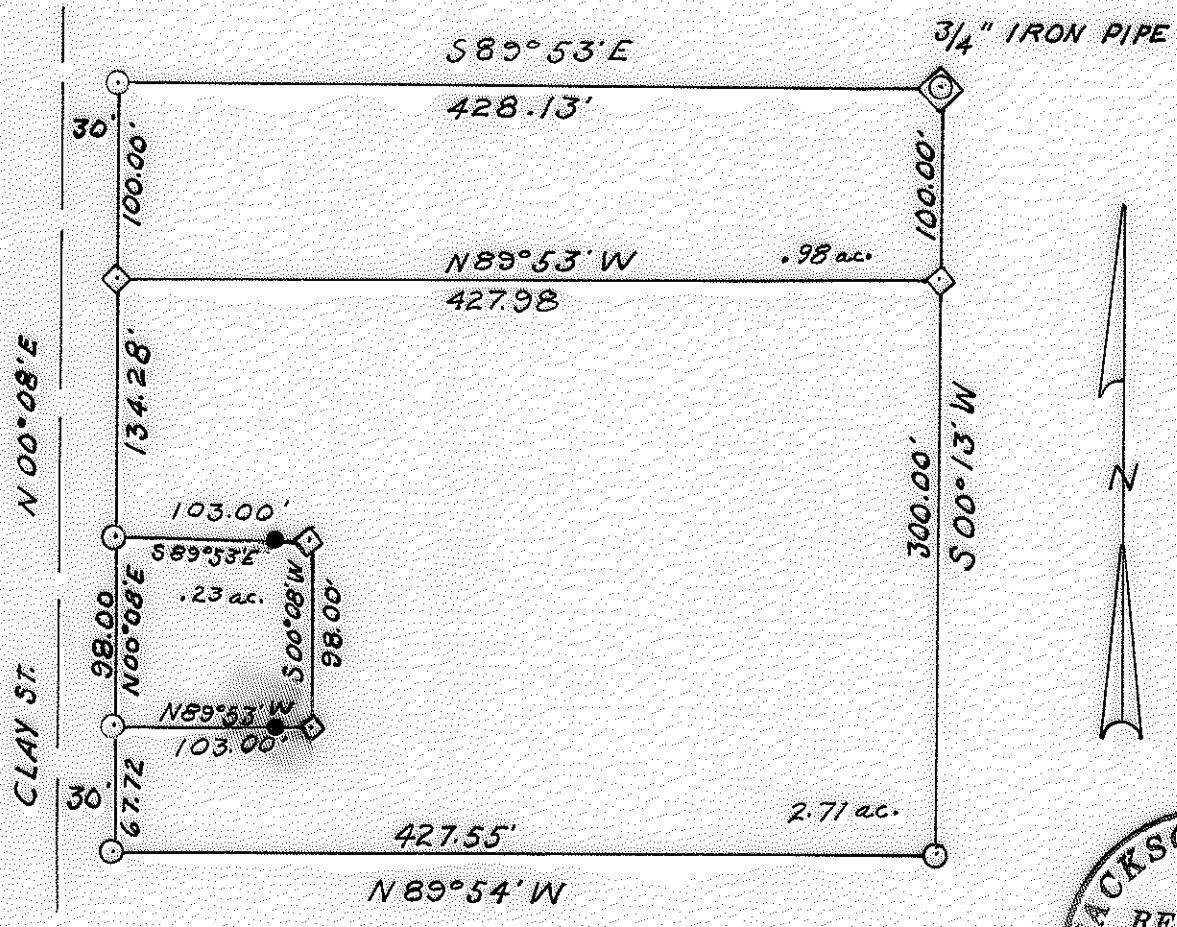

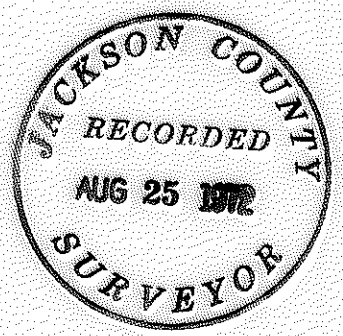

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

SURVEY FOR: Herbert Wycoff
675 Tolman Creek Road
Ashland, Oregon 97520

PURPOSE: To monument a strip of land 100 feet wide along the northerly edge of the large tract and move the rear pins on the smaller tract to achieve a minimum lot size of 10,000 square feet as shown on the accompanying plat.

PROCEDURE: I recovered the 5/8" X 24" rebar set on Survey NO. 4665 and then set 5/8" X 24" rebar for the 100 foot strip of land along the northerly edge of the property, and then I moved the rear pins of the small tract to the east to achieve a minimum lot size of 10,000 square feet as shown on the accompanying plat.
