The southerly line of this subdivision was surveyed and monumented by Hugh Ingle in an unrecorded survey for Willard Ball, dated

February, 1960, a copy of which is attached. The original legal descriptions, bearing Ingle's registered engineer stamp, prepared from this unrecorded survey were found in Title Company files.

The monuments set on the resulting division line were held for line control, and were located as follows: A \(\frac{1}{2}^{\text{fl}} \) iron pin was found
